The YMCA is providing an alternative to learning at home with a school day program for students enrolled in the Remote School option. Two sites are available: the Vickrey Center (Pensacola) and the Pullum Y (Navarre).

How will YMCA Academy be organized?

- Students will be grouped in Learning Circles with their peers and follow the school day under the supervision of a trained and screened YMCA staff proctor.
- The program will run from 7 am-2 pm. Parents can choose to add before-school or afterschool if they choose.
- Students will follow the school day, including lunch and recess.
- Before-school and afterschool programs are licensed and offer homework support, snack, character development and STEAM.

Is it safe for my child to attend?

- Learning Circles will consist of 10-15 children with one staff proctor. Each circle will have its own classroom, and students will have assigned seats in smaller groups of no more than 5 students. We will maintain consistent groups and staff with each group to reduce exposure.
- Staff receive daily temperature checks and are required to wear face masks. We follow social distancing, proper handwashing procedures, and approved sanitizing protocols.

What will my child need to attend?

- Children age 6 and older will be required to wear face masks.
- Students will bring their own lunch and computer.

How do I sign up?
